#### **Convergence Framework**

The Convergence framework shapes everything we do—it's what makes this residency such a unique and transformative experience. By getting a feel for how it works, you'll be ready to dive into the collaborative workshops, interdisciplinary projects, and rigorous creative opportunities that will help propel your work forward. This is a space where diverse perspectives come together, and magic happens when we all contribute in different ways. Understanding the process means you'll make the most of your time here and take your creative journey to new heights.

#### **Umbrella Project**

Each year, we select a director who brings a clear vision to integrate the talents of all artists into an inclusive, interdisciplinary work that anchors the residency. Every Convergence artist actively contributes to crafting this unique, collaborative piece.

Our 2025 Umbrella Project will be directed by Convergence alum Leila Ghaznavi.

#### Side Project

The goal of a Side Project is to help you advance an idea that needs development and move it to the next stage. Whatever your next step is, the Convergence is designed to provide the artists, feedback, and support necessary to develop your work at a professional level.

Each Side Project is allocated eight (8) hours of rehearsal time. If desired, you can present your Side Project as a "work-in-progress" during the Open Lab Performance.

Side Projects are typically genre-specific, but we encourage applicants to incorporate artists from a variety of backgrounds and disciplines.

#### Workshop

Everyone in the Convergence leads a workshop in their area of expertise, and attendance at each workshop is required.

These workshops form a core part of the Convergence experience, offering you and your cohort opportunities to share knowledge and broaden your skill set. Artists are encouraged to apply new techniques and insights gained from these workshops to their Side Projects.

We believe artists should share their craft and passion. For those new to teaching, we're happy to help you develop a lesson plan before the Convergence. Simply teach what you know best and love most about your art!

Past workshops have explored topics such as Theater Sustainability, Karate, Aerial Dance, Puppetry, Social Media for Non-Profits, Improvisatory Singing, and Dance for Parkinson's.

#### **Open Lab Performance**

Held on the last day of the Convergence, the Open Lab Performance is the final tool supporting your creative journey. This informal presentation provides an opportunity to share your work with an audience, adding urgency and focus to your creative process.

While your presentation may include basic technical elements, it's understood to be a work-inprogress, not a polished performance. Following the performance, the audience engages with artists, offering invaluable feedback and insights to propel your project forward.


